

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS

From time to time there are groups or individuals who wish to address the Board and make formal presentation to convey publicly items of interest, commendations, special request, expressions of concern, and other relative topics. Persons who desire to address the Board may speak to the Board if they have signed up fifteen minutes (15) prior to the scheduled commencement of the meeting.

The time allotted to delegations shall be limited to five (5) minutes for each delegation. When problems are presented by the delegations, decisions concerning their resolution will be reached after study by the Board and the administrative staff of the school system.
